

# ABOUT SANTA CLARA UNIVERSITY

Located in the heart of the beautiful Silicon Valley, Santa Clara University is ten minutes away from San Jose and one hour away from San Francisco and Santa Cruz.

Santa Clara University (SCU) is famous for its small class sizes which create an intimate learning environment where the students and teachers get to know each other. In addition, students are very involved and run over 100 club organizations.

SCU currently has 530 full-time professors and 399 part-time lecturers.

The academic year is divided into 3 quarters: Fall – Winter – Spring. Student exchange applying to SCU for the academic year attend Fall, Winter, and Spring quarters.

**Exams:** Exams occur during the last week of the quarter


**Grading:** Letter grades A - F

## **Application & Visas**

#### **Application Requirements:**

• Students are required to complete an application via the Santa Clara University: Incoming Exchange Student Application. Students will request their supplemental materials be scanned uploaded by the Exchange Coordinator via their application. Hardcopies are not required.

#### **Visa Requirements:**

 Students with questions regarding the visa process and completing the proper documents should visit the International Students & Scholars website.

#### **Health Insurance Requirement:**

 Comprehensive health insurance is required by the U.S. government as well as Santa Clara University policy. All international students in F-1 or J-1 status are automatically enrolled in and charged for the SCU Student Health Insurance Plan.




